


# Commercial Dumpster Enclosure Guide

Thank you for signing up for our commercial dumpster service. Please follow our enclosure guidelines to ensure safe and on-time pickup.

Before beginning any project, please check with your local municipality for rules and regulations regarding your commercial dumpster enclosure.



## **Gate Opening**

Make sure the gate has a minimum of a 10-foot opening. The hinges should be on the outside of the building wall. If your container doesn't have wheels, our truck will need space to drive into the enclosure to empty the container. Also, make sure you have gate stops so we can hold the gate open when dumping the container. Gates cannot stop at a 45-degree angle; otherwise the truck can hit them and cause damage.

### **Building Materials**

We recommend using only long-lasting, quality materials. Please contact us for recommendations. Also, be sure to check with your local municipality for any height or material restrictions. There should be a 6-inch-thick concrete pad inside the enclosure, placed at least 8 feet from the opening. (This helps reduce damage to the pavement and our trucks.)

### **Depth of Enclosure**

Allow a minimum of 10-feet for a front loading container. The measurements above allow for an 8-yard container. Give us a call to determine what size dumpster will best fit your enclosure. Please leave enough space for employees to walk on either side, particularly if you need a grease or recycling container. We also recommend a side opening so employees don't have to open the large entry door.

#### Truck Access

To ensure safety, please leave about 35–45 feet of unobstructed clearance in front of your enclosure to give our trucks direct access.
